

ORDINANCE 16-14

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE USE OF SMALL WIND ENERGY SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, it is the purpose of this ordinance to promote the safe, effective and efficient use of small wind energy systems to reduce the on-site consumption of utility-supplied electricity; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Highlands finds that:

- 1) Wind energy is an abundant, renewable, and nonpolluting energy resource;
- 2) Converting wind to electricity will reduce our dependence on nonrenewable energy resources, and decrease the air and water pollution that results from the use of conventional energy sources;
- 3) Distributed small wind energy systems will also enhance the reliability and power quality of the power grid, reduce peak power demands, and help diversify the State's energy supply portfolio; and
- 4) Small wind energy systems make the electricity supply market more competitive by promoting customer choice; and

WHEREAS, New Jersey's Renewable Portfolio Standards (RPS) require each supplier/provider, as defined at N.J.A.C. 14:8-1.2, that sells electricity to retail customers in New Jersey to provide a percentage of their retail electricity sales from renewable energy sources, beginning at 3.5 percent in 2004 and increasing to 22.5 percent by 2021; and

WHEREAS, existing local zoning regulations do not address wind power, which while not intended to discourage the installation of small wind turbines, can substantially increase the time and costs required to obtain necessary local land-use permits; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of Borough of Highlands find that it is necessary to standardize and streamline the requirements for small wind energy systems so that this clean, renewable energy resource can be utilized in a cost-effective and timely manner in our municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the Borough of Highlands that:

00.01 Title.

This ordinance may be referred to as the Small Wind Energy System Ordinance.

00.02 Authority.

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Borough of Highlands authority.

00.03 Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to:

- (1) Facilitate the permitting of small wind energy systems.
- (2) Preserve and protect public health and safety without significantly increasing the cost or decreasing the efficiency of a small wind energy system.

00.04 Definitions. In this ordinance:

- (1) "Administrator" means the Borough of Highlands Land Use Administrator or Planning and Zoning Administrator or Zoning Officer and/or Code Enforcement Officer or their duly authorized designee as applicable.
- (2) "Board" means the Borough of Highlands or other Authority Having Jurisdiction.
- (3) "Meteorological tower" or "met tower" means a structure designed to support the gathering of wind energy resource data, and includes the tower, base plate, anchors, guy cables and hardware, anemometers (wind speed indicators), wind direction vanes, booms to hold equipment anemometers and vanes, data logger, instrument wiring, and any telemetry devices that are used to monitor or transmit wind speed and wind flow characteristics over a period of time for either instantaneous wind information or to characterize the wind resource at a given location.
- (4) "Owner" shall mean the individual or entity that intends to own and operate the small wind energy system in accordance with this ordinance.
- (5) "Rotor diameter" means the cross sectional dimension of the circle swept by the rotating blades of a wind-powered energy generator.
- (6) "Small wind energy system" means a wind energy system, as defined in this section, that (a) is used to generate electricity; (b) has a nameplate capacity of 100 kilowatts or less; and (c) is as high as necessary to capture the wind energy resource at heights to be determined based on specific studies for the intended use.
- (7) "Total height" means, in relation to a wind energy system, the vertical distance from the ground to the tip of a wind generator blade when the tip is at its highest point.
- (8) "Tower" means a monopole, freestanding, or guyed structure that supports a wind generator.
- (9) "Wind energy system" means a wind generator and all associated equipment, including any base, blade, foundation, nacelle, rotor, tower, transformer, vane, wire, inverter, batteries or other component necessary to fully utilize the wind generator.
- (10) "Wind generator" means equipment that converts energy from the wind into electricity. This term includes the rotor, blades and associated mechanical and electrical conversion components necessary to generate, store and/or transfer energy.

00.05 Standards.

A small wind energy system shall be a permitted use in all zones subject to the following requirements:

- (1) Setbacks. A wind tower for a small wind energy system shall be set back a distance equal to the town's building set back requirements. No portion of the wind generator shall extend beyond the setback line, nor into the following:
 - (a) any public road right of way, unless written permission is granted by the government entity with jurisdiction over the road right of way;
 - (b) any overhead utility lines, unless written permission is granted by the utility that owns and/or controls the lines.
- (2) Access.

- (a) All ground-mounted electrical and control equipment shall be labeled and secured to
- prevent unauthorized access.
- (b) The tower shall be designed and installed so as not to provide step bolts, a ladder, or other publicly accessible means of climbing the tower, for a minimum height of eight feet above the ground.
- (3) Lighting. A small wind energy system shall not be artificially lighted unless such lighting is required by the Federal Aviation Administration.
- (4) Appearance, Color, and Finish. The wind generator and the tower shall remain painted or finished in the color or finish that was originally applied by the manufacturer, unless a different color of finish is approved in the zoning approval.
- (5) Signs. There shall be no signs that are visible from any public road posted on a small wind generator system or any associated building, except for the manufacturer's or installer's identification, appropriate warning signs, or owner identification.
- (6) Utility notification and interconnection. Small wind energy systems that connect to the electric utility shall comply with the New Jersey's Net Metering and Interconnection Standards for Class I Renewable Energy Systems at N.J.A.C. 14:4-9
- (7) Met towers. A met tower shall be permitted under the same standards, permit requirements, restoration requirements and permit procedures as a small wind energy system.
- 00.06 Permit Requirements.
- (1) Permit. A zoning permit shall be required for the installation of a small wind energy system.
- (2) Documents: The zoning permit application shall be accompanied by a plot plan which includes the following:
 - (a) Property lines and physical dimensions of the property;
 - (b) Location, dimensions, and types of existing major structures on the property;
 - (c) Location of the proposed small wind energy system tower;
 - (d) The right-of-way of any public road that is contiguous with the property;
 - (e) Any overhead utility lines;
 - (f) Small wind energy system specifications, including manufacturer and model, rotor diameter, tower height, tower type (freestanding or guyed);
- (3) Fees. The application for a zoning permit for a small wind energy system must be accompanied by the fee required.
- (4) Expiration. A permit issued pursuant to this ordinance shall expire if:
 - (a) The small wind energy system is not installed and functioning within 24-months from
 - the date the permit is issued; or
 - (b) The small wind energy system is out of service or otherwise unused for a continuous 18-month period.

00.07 Abandonment.

- (1) A small wind energy system that is out-of-service for a continuous 18 -month period will be deemed to have been abandoned.
- (2) The Administrator may issue a Notice of Abandonment to the owner of a small wind energy system that is deemed to have been abandoned. The notice shall be sent return receipt requested.
- (3) The Owner shall have the right to respond to the Notice of Abandonment within 30 days from Notice receipt date.
- (4) If the owner provides information that demonstrates the small wind energy system has not been abandoned, the Administrator shall withdraw the Notice of Abandonment and notify the owner that the Notice has been withdrawn.
- (5) If the Administrator determines that the small wind energy system has been abandoned, the Owner of the small wind energy system shall remove the wind generator from the tower at the Owner's sole expense within 6 months after the Owner receives the Notice of Abandonment.
- (6) If the owner fails to remove the wind generator from the tower in the time allowed under (5) above, the Administrator may pursue legal action to have the wind generator removed at the Owner's expense.

00.08 Zoning Permit Procedure.

- (1) An Owner shall submit an application to the Administrator for a zoning permit for a small wind energy system.
- (2) The Administrator shall issue a permit or deny the application within one month as consistent with Municipal Land Use Law of the date on which the application is received.
- (3) If the application is approved, the Administrator will return one signed copy of the application with the zoning permit and retain the other copy with the application.
- (4) If the application is rejected, the Administrator will notify the applicant in writing and provide a written statement of the reason why the application was rejected. The applicant may appeal the Administrator's decision pursuant to the appropriate appeals authority. The applicant may reapply if the deficiencies specified by the Administrator are resolved.
- 00.09 Violations. (1) It is unlawful for any person to construct, install, or operate a small wind energy system that is not in compliance with this ordinance.
- (2) Small wind energy systems installed prior to the adoption of this ordinance are exempt from the requirements of this ordinance, except for the provisions at 00.07 regarding abandonment.

00.10 Administration and Enforcement.

- (1) This ordinance shall be administered by the Administrator or other official as designated.
- (2) The Administrator may enter any property for which a permit has been issued under this ordinance to conduct an inspection to determine whether the conditions stated in the permit have been met.
- (3) The Administrator may issue orders to abate any violation of this ordinance.
- (4) The Administrator may issue a citation for any violation of this ordinance.
- (5) The Administrator may refer any violation of this ordinance to legal counsel for enforcement.
- 00.11 Penalties. (1) Any person who fails to comply with any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to enforcement and penalties as set forth in Article XXI, Chapter 99 (21-99) of the Zoning and Land Use Regulations of the Borough of Highlands. (2) Nothing in this section

shall be construed to prevent the Borough of Highlands Board from using any other lawful means to enforce this ordinance.

00.12 Severability.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable, and the invalidity of any section, subdivision, paragraph, or other part of this ordinance shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of the ordinance.

00.13 Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

00.14 Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage as provided by law.



ORDINANCE 16-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER EIGHT OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS TO REGULATE SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL ON SIDEWALKS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Highlands ("the Borough") has enacted ordinances to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens, which is codified in the Code of the Borough of Highlands ("the Code"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to supplement Chapter 8 of the Code to include section 8:5, "Snow and Ice Removal," which would require property owners and/or tenants to remove snow and ice from sidewalks that abut their land.

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes also to include Section 8:5-1, "Treatment of Ice," which would require property owners and/or tenants to treat sidewalks that abut their property with ashes, sand, cinders, sawdust or other material designed to prevent pedestrians from slipping and falling.

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to further include Section 8:5-2, "Violations and Penalties," which will enforce a penalty if this chapter is violated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Highlands, the County of Monmouth, in the State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Section 8:5 shall be added to read as follows:

Section 8:5 Snow and Ice Removal.

The owner or tenant of land abutting upon the sidewalk of any street or avenue shall remove all snow and ice from the sidewalk within 12 daylight hours after same shall have formed or fallen thereon.

Section 8:5-1 Treatment of Ice.

The owner or tenant of land abutting or bounding upon the sidewalks of any street or avenue shall, when such sidewalks may become icy or otherwise slippery, place thereon ashes, sand, cinders, sawdust or other material designed to prevent pedestrians from slipping and falling and shall at all times keep such sidewalks in a safe and passable condition.

Section 8:5-2 Certain Persons Exempt from Requirements

Any owner or tenant of land abutting upon the sidewalk of any street or avenue who is unable to remove snow and ice and/or provide for the treatment of ice due to a physical or medical disability or due to age or infirmness, shall contact the Code Enforcement Officer and/or his designee, within 12 daylight hours after snow and ice has formed or fallen. Such owner or tenant with a physical or medical disability or inability to remove and/or treat snow and ice due to age or infirmness, will not be subject to the violations and penalties delineated in Section 8:5-3, subject to the discretion of the Code Enforcement Officer.

Section 8:5-3 Violations and Penalties.

<u>Violations are punishable by fine, imprisonment, or community service in the discretion of the Judge in accordance with N.J.S.A.</u> 40:49-5.

SECTION TWO. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

SECTION THREE. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION FOUR. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE 16-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, SECTION 43 (2-43), "OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS RELATED TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Borough has established an Open Space Trust Fund as more specifically set forth in Chapter II, Section 42 (2-42) of the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has established an Open Space Committee, as more specifically set forth in Chapter II, Section 43 (2-43) of the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has made a determination to utilize open space trust funds to acquire, preserve and improve lands for open space, conservation, recreation and parklands by the Borough of Highlands; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has analyzed and evaluated the Borough Code and has recommended a change with respect to the scope of duties of the Open Space Committee as set forth in Chapter II, Section 43 (2-43); and

WHEREAS, the governing body finds that this recommendation is in the best interests of the residents of the Borough of Highlands and should be adopted for the general welfare of the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the Borough of Highlands as follows:

The following section of Chapter II, Section 43.4, entitled "Powers and Duties" of the Open Space Committee, of the Code of the Borough of Highlands, shall be amended and supplemented as follows: (underscores represent additions):

SECTION I.

2-43 OPEN SPACE COMMITTEE.

2-43.1 Establishment.

There is hereby established an open space committee, which shall consist of seven members, whose terms and powers are hereinafter set forth.

2-43.2 Membership.

The open space committee shall be comprised of the following persons:

- a. One member of the Borough Council of the Borough of Highlands appointed by the mayor and borough council.
 - b. Six citizens of the borough appointed by the mayor and borough council.

2-43.3 Terms.

- a. The member of the borough council appointed to the open space committee shall have a term of one year.
- b. The terms of the citizen members shall be for three years. However, when the committee is first constituted, two committee members shall be appointed to and serve a one-year term initially, two committee members shall be appointed to and serve a two-year term initially and two committee members shall be appointed to and serve a full three-year term. This will provide for two committee members being appointed each year to a full three-year term after the initial creation of the committee.

2-43.4 Powers and Duties.

- a. The open space committee shall initially prepare a report recommending which parcels of land should be acquired in fee and/or those parcels of land from which the Borough should acquire development rights only.
- b. The open space committee shall submit to the Borough Council a prioritized list of properties which it recommends that the Borough acquire and/or properties from which it recommends that development rights should be acquired.
- c. The borough council is to determine the properties or development rights to be acquired by gift, purchase or by eminent domain proceedings, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 20:3-1 et seq., within the financial constraints it establishes for such acquisition.
- d. The open space committee shall also advise the borough council as to the parcels of land for which it recommends the Borough use funds from the Open Space Trust Fund, in order to preserve and improve lands for open space, conservation, recreation and parklands by the Borough of Highlands.
- e. The borough council will review the recommendations of the open space committee, as to the specific parcels of lands for which it recommends the Borough use funds from the Open Space Trust Fund, for the preservation and improvement of lands for open space, conservation, recreation and parklands. The borough council will then make a determination as to whether to utilize funds from the Open Space Trust Fund, in order to preserve and improve the specific parcels of land, recommended by the open

space committee, for open space, conservation, recreation and parklands by the Borough of Highlands.

2-43.5 Public Meetings.

The open space committee shall hold public meetings, which public meetings shall be held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act and the borough council shall give appropriate notification of said meetings.

2-43.6 Officers.

The open space committee shall select from among its members a chairman, and a vice-chairman to serve as the presiding officer in the absence of the chairman. The committee shall also appoint a secretary whose function shall be to maintain minutes of the committee's meeting and records of the proceedings of the committee.

2-43.7 Initial Organization Meeting.

The open space committee shall hold its initial organization meeting shortly after this section takes effect.

2-43.8 Sale of Property.

No property acquired with the funds from the reserve for open space acquisition shall be leased or sold, until the sale or lease of the same has been authorized by the borough council in the manner prescribed by law.

2-43.9 Reviews and Reports.

In the event that no property is acquired under this chapter for a period of five consecutive years, then the borough council shall review the activities of the open space committee and issue a report with recommendations and conclusions concerning the reserve for open space acquisition.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION IV. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage as provided by law.



ORDINANCE 16-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS, MONMOUTH COUNTY, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, TO MANDATE DIRECT DEPOSIT FOR MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 52:14-15f ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28, authorizes local governments to mandate direct deposit for certain governmental employees effective after July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 2013 c. 28, permits governing bodies to grant exemptions on such terms and conditions as they deem necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Highlands, located in Monmouth County, State of New Jersey as follows:

- **Section 1.** All employees and elected public officials who receive compensation from the Borough of Highlands are mandated to have direct deposit of their compensation as of November 1, 2016 in accordance with Chapter 28 P.L. 2013, as defined under N.J.S.A. 52:14-15f(b).
- **Section 2.** Seasonal and temporary employees who are employed by the Borough of Highlands are exempt from the direct deposit mandate.
- Section 3. Borough employees may request, in writing, an exemption from the direct deposit mandate to the Borough Administrator of the Borough of Highlands. Such requests will be presented to the governing body within thirty (30) days or at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Highlands, after the request is received by the Borough Administrator. The governing body may grant such an exemption by Resolution and only for good cause.
- Section 4. If any Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- **Section 5.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **Section 6.** This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PLANNING BOARD TO UNDERTAKE A PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION TO DETERMINE WHETHER BLOCK 105.107, LOT 1.1, QUALIFIES FOR DESIGNATION AS AN AREA IN NEED OF REDEVELOPMENT PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 ET. SEQ.

WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law, <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:12A-1 et seq. ("LRHL") authorizes municipalities to determine whether certain parcels of land located therein constitute areas in need of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Highlands desires to explore whether the real property located at Block 105.107, Lot 1.1, commonly referred to as the Shadow Lawn Mobile Home Park site (the "Study Area"), may be an appropriate area for consideration for the program of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Highlands considers it to be in the best interest of the Borough to have the Planning Board conduct such an investigation for the property located at Block 105.107, Lot. 1.1, commonly referred to as the Shadow Lawn Mobile Home Park site; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Highlands believes the subject parcel is potentially valuable for contributing to, serving, and protecting the public health, safety and welfare and for the promotion of smart growth within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Local Redevelopment and Housing Law sets forth a specific procedure for establishing an area in need of redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 49A:12A-6, prior to the governing body of the Borough of Highlands making a determination as to whether the Study Area qualifies as an area in need of redevelopment, the governing body must authorize the Planning Board, by resolution, to undertake a preliminary investigation to determine whether the Study Area meets the criteria for designation as an area in need of redevelopment as set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Highlands wishes to direct the Planning Board to undertake such preliminary investigation to determine whether the Study Area meets the criteria for designation as an area in need of redevelopment pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 and in accordance with the investigation and hearing process set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1 et. seq.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the governing body of the Borough of Highlands hereby directs the Borough of Highlands Planning Board to conduct the necessary investigation and to hold a public hearing to determine whether the Study area defined hereinabove qualifies for designation as an area in need of redevelopment under the criteria and pursuant to the public hearing process set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-1, et. seq.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the redevelopment area determination shall further authorize the municipality to use all those powers provided by the New Jersey Legislature for use in a redevelopment area, other than the use of eminent domain (hereinafter referred to as a "Non-Condemnation Redevelopment Area").

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Planning Board shall submit its findings and recommendations to the governing body of the Borough of Highlands in the form of a Resolution with supportive documentation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Acting Borough Clerk, Chief Financial Officer and Borough Planning Board and Planning Board Secretary.
