Resolution 20-102

A Resolution Declaring an Emergent Condition and Authorizing Emergency Contracts without Public Bidding Pursuant to the Provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6

WHEREAS, an emergent condition developed throughout March of 2020 as a result of the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19) in the State of New Jersey; and

WHERAS, on March 16, 2020 Governor Phil Murphy issued Executive Order No. 104 imposing numerous restrictions throughout the State pursuant to the prior declaration of a state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 permits the Borough to award contracts without public bidding or quotes when an emergency affecting the health, welfare and safety of the public requires the immediate performance of services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Highlands that authorization is hereby given to the Borough Administrator to proceed with emergency contracts without public bidding pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-6 and in compliance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.12, until such time that the state of emergency is resolved.
