Resolution 20-126

A Resolution Extending the Property Tax Payment Grace Period

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 54:4-66 and -67, the nonpayment of property taxes by May 11, 2020 shall result in interest being charged at a rate of 8% per annum on the first \$1,500.00 of the delinquency and 18% per annum on any amount in excess of \$1,500.00, to be calculated from the date the tax was payable until the date that actual payment to the tax collector is made; and

WHEREAS, Governor Murphy has issued Executive Order No. 130 permitting municipalities to extend the property tax payment grace period due to the COVID-19 crisis; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Borough of Highlands wishes to extend the property tax payment grace period for the payment of quarterly taxes due on May 1, 2020 until June 1, 2020 in accordance with Executive Order No. 130; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the Borough of Highlands hereby extends the property tax payment grace period until June 1, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to make corrections and notations upon the Municipal records as may be necessary to effect this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Borough Tax Collector and the Borough Chief Financial Officer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the municipal clerk shall notify the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the adoption of this resolution within three business days of its adoption as required by Executive Order 130.
