PROCLAMATION

TO ALL DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS AND OFFICES OF THE BOROUGH OF Highlands, NEW JERSEY AND TO ALL CITIZENS OF THE COUNTY AND PERSONS WITHIN ITS BOUNDARIES

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO THE POWERS VESTED IN ME BY CHAPTER 251 OF THE LAWS OF 1942, AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED, NJSA APP A:9-30 ET SEQ; NJSA 40:48-1(6) AND ordinance PURSUANT THERETO; R.S. 40:87-31 ET SEQ, NJSA 2C:33-1 ET SEQ; AND ALL SECTIONS AND SUBSECTIONS, I HAVE DECLARED THAT A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY EXISTS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS, AND

WHEREAS, THE AFORESAID LAWS AUTHORIZE THE PROMULGATION OF SUCH ORDERS, RULES AND REGULATIONS AS ARE NECESSARY TO MEET THE VARIOUS PROBLEMS WHICH HAVE OR MAY BE PRESENTED BY SUCH EMERGENCY, AND,

WHEREAS, BY REASON OF THE SERIOUS CONDITIONS WHICH PRESENTLY EXIST IN CERTAIN AREAS OF THE BOROUGH WHICH MAY AFFECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND OR WELFARE OF THE PEOPLE, AND

WHEREAS, IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT CERTAIN AREAS OF THE BOROUGH SHOULD BE DECLARED DISASTER AREAS, AND FURTHER, THAT CERTAIN MEASURES MUST BE TAKEN IN ORDER TO INSURE THAT THE AUTHORITIES WILL BE UNHAMPERED IN THEIR EFFORTS TO MAINTAIN LAW AND ORDER AS WELL AS AN ORDERLY FLOW OF TRAFFIC, AND FURTHER, IN ORDER TO PROTECT THE PERSONS AND PROPERTY AFFECTED BY SAID CONDITIONS BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT,

A. This declaration is Borough Wide.

AND

At the discretion of the Highlands Police Department,
Abandoned Vehicles on the streets, highways and public
roadways, or unable to continue due to conditions of the
emergency will be towed away at the expense of the vehicle's
owner.

AND

B. Other necessary orders as needed.

NOW THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AFORESAID LAWS, I DO
HEREBY PROMULGATE AND DECLARE THAT THE ABOVE CITED APPLICABLE
REGULATIONS SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER LAWS OF THE
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND ITS
MUNICIPALITIES.
