

BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS MAYOR'S MONTHLY REPORT

22 Snug Harbor Avenue, Highlands NJ 07732 Sunday, January 1, 2023, at 7:00 PM

The December Report is as follows. All constructions dates are weather & supply-chain permitting:

- Construction Updates
 - North St pump upgrades Completed 12/7/22.
 - Municipal Building Interior work and exterior stone veneer is ongoing.
 - Snug Harbor Park Updates Should be completed in January.
 - Marine PI Elevated Walkway West [Snug Harbor] We are waiting for railings and the trash bins.
 - Waterwitch Pump Station Construction began 11/28/22.
 - Ederle Park Updates Work started 12/2/22. Should be completed by February.
 - Skate Park Application was approved by CARFA and Green Acres. Work to start in January.
 - I-Bank large sanitary sewer project for Waterwitch Area Phase 1 Starting in Jan in this order: Central,
 Ocean, Beach, Gravelly, William, Ralph, North, Waterwitch, Linden, Bay. Hopefully completed by June.
 - 171 Bay Ave EV Charging Station Charging station has been ordered. Installation by April 2023.
 - o Jones Creek County will do East section [Snug Harbor] CAFRA permit was submitted in Dec.
 - o **Portland Road Guard Rail** Waiting on the County to repair.
- Projects Planned
 - Reconstruction of Bayside Drive & Marie St From Shore Dr to Borough border. Work includes sanitary sewer main replacement, storm drainage improvements and paving. DOT grant \$246,850.
 - Update Frank Hall Park Joint venture with the Open Space/Lions Club/Green Team looking for grants.
 - Update Vets Park Plans are with Engineering. Local Recreation grant from DCA \$75,000.
 - Create Overlook Park [empty lot on NJSH 36] Plans are with Engineering.
 - Marine PI Elevated walkway East [Sea Drift] CME submitted Monmouth County Open Space grant.
 - o **2021 Resiliency Plan** –Received a grant for design & engineering for living shoreline & bulkhead at Veteran's Park. We are working on funding for the Snug Harbor pump and surrounding area.
- Regionalization Update
 - o The attorneys & towns have agreed on the mediator. We are waiting for the School Boards to agree.
- Grants/Funding Update We were awarded \$808,518 in 2022.
 - Submitted the FEMA BRIC [Building Resilient Infrastructure & Communities] grant funding for the Snug Harbor Pump station and to mitigate the runoff from Monmouth Hills. Sent to NJOEM 11/18. Also submitted DOT Grants: Local Transportation Projects Fund 2023 & Local Aid Infrastructure Fund 2023.
- Monmouth Hills Runoff
 - On-going discussions with Monmouth Hills HOA, State, County and Middletown officials.
- Community Rating System [CRS] program for lower flood insurance.
 - We are waiting for Region 2 Floodplain Management & Insurance (FM&I) Branch to complete a
 Compliance Audit. We were notified this will not happen in 2022, no date has been given to us yet.
 - We need to enter into an Information Sharing Access Agreement (ISAA) with FEMA to gain access to their records of noncompliant properties. An email requesting next steps has been sent to FEMA.
