

BOROUGH OF HIGHLANDS 2023 HIGHLANDS BOARDS SURVEY RESULTS 22 Snug Harbor Avenue, Highlands NJ 07732

Wednesday, July 19, 2023 at 7:00 PM

Background and Objectives: The survey is designed to provide accurate tracking from year to year on the Diversity of the Boards, Commissions and Committees [Boards] of the Borough of Highlands. Using the survey results, the goal is to solicit membership that more precisely reflects the composition of the Borough.

Data Collection: All respondents were residents or those who work in Highlands and are members of a Board, Committee or Commission. Logistically, a survey was created for interviewing online as well as a data entry module for paper surveys. The survey's duration was an average of 1 minute. The survey was promoted through email and Board Chairs to encourage a good response. Study period was 6/18/23 through 6/30/23.

Demographics: Highlands has a population of 4,621 according to the 2020 US Census. A breakdown of diversity characteristics are listed on the next page.

Action Standard: This research will be used to provide the Mayor and Governing Body with information as to how we, as a community, should address achieving diversity that matches our demographics on our Boards in the future. These results will also be shared with Borough residents and the Team at Sustainable Jersey.

Conclusions and Recommendations: There are 65 seats on our Boards. Once we remove for duplicate members of multiple boards, we have 55 members. 55 respondents answered Q1-Q5, with only 9 who offered an open-ended response to Q6: Please let us know if you have any other comments that would be helpful regarding diversity in Highlands.

The recommendation is to continue to monitor diversity on our Boards to ensure those members accurately reflect our community. While some Boards are more diverse than others, we are close to Census figures for our town overall. The recommendation to improve better representation is to share this report with the community as well as ask more Hispanics, people of color and women volunteer to serve on our Boards, Commissions and Committees.

Another recommendation is to include a question regarding members with disabilities. Next year, we will include: "Are you a person living with a disability?" with a Yes or No response.





Q1 Which of the following do you volunteer for? Chose as many as apply.







Q3 Which of the following best describes your Race? Please pick one.


