Three-year term - term to expire 12/31/2027

Qualifications of Candidates

Each candidate shall be a registered voter of the Borough of Highlands and a resident of the Borough for at least one (1) year immediately prior to the date of the Election.

Campaign Contributions

All candidates are required to comply with the Campaign Contributions and Expenditures Act (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et seq.).

All reports required by said Act are the responsibility of candidates and are to be made to the Election Law Enforcement Commission and any questions should be directed to them at 1-609-292-8700.

CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES

As a candidate for Council Member in the Municipal Election to be held during the General Election on November 5, 2024, you are permitted to expend money in furtherance or aid of your candidacy. However, before receiving any contributions or expending any money, you should familiarize yourself with the provisions of the New Jersey Campaign Contribution and Expenditures Reporting Act (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-1 et seq.)

You are advised that before you can accept or expend any monies in connection with the forthcoming election, you must first appoint a Campaign Treasurer and Campaign Depository and file with the New Jersey Election Law Enforcement Commission.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PETITION SIGNATORIES

- Each signature on the petition shall accompany the name and address of the petitioner. **No one may sign a petition for more positions than are on the ballot:**

Council Member – 2 Petitions Only

Petitions will be certified in the order in which they are received for filing

- The registered voter must sign for him/herself; No one else can sign for them.
- It is important to make sure the signers are registered voters. A list of registered voters in the Borough of Highlands can be obtained from the Monmouth County Superintendent of Elections/Commissioner of Registration's Office in Freehold. Their address is 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold. Their telephone number is (732) 431-7780.
- The candidate for office and his/her campaign manager shall file an oath that the statements made in the petitions are true and that each signature appended thereto is the genuine signature of the person whose name it purports to be to their best knowledge and belief.
- Petitions must be filed on or before 4:00pm - Monday, August 22, 2024* {Pursuant to NJSA 40:45-8}. Persons delivering petitions must be inside the Municipal Clerk's Office by 4:00 PM on August 22, 2024. **Although the deadline is August 22, 2024, petitions can be filed as soon as they are complete which will allow time for correction prior to the deadline.**
- It is recommended that you obtain more than the minimum number of signatures in the event petitions are disqualified. (Recommended number of signatures: 50)

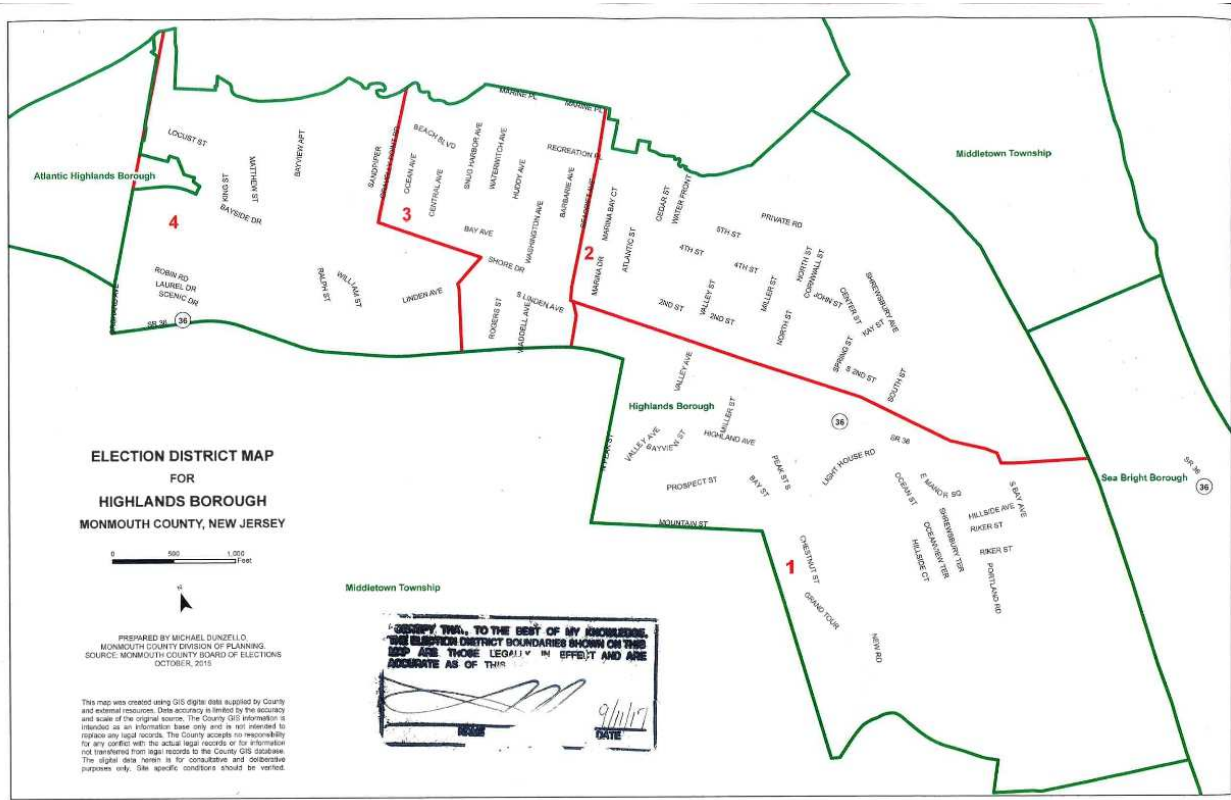

ELECTIONEERING
[N.J.S.A. 19:34-5 TO 19:34-15]

- A. No person shall, during an election, with intent to hinder or delay same, or to hinder or delay any voter in the preparation of his ballot, remove or destroy any of the ballots or pencils placed in the booths or compartments for the purpose of enabling the voter to prepare his ballot.
- B. Any person willfully violating any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of disorderly persons offense.
- C. Obstruction or Interfering with Polling Place or Voters:
1. No person shall tamper, deface or interfere with polling booth.
 2. No person shall obstruct the entrance to any polling place.
 3. No person shall obstruct or interfere with any voter.
 4. No person shall loiter in or near the polling place, or, with the purpose to obstruct or interfere with any voter or to unduly delay other voters from voting, or spend an inordinate amount of time in the polling booth
 5. No person shall electioneer within the polling place.
 6. No person shall electioneer within one hundred feet (100) of any polling place.
 7. This shall not be construed to prohibit a minor from entering a polling place on the day of an election to vote in a simulated election at that polling place as permitted by N.J.S.A. 19:34-6b.
- D. Electioneering Within or About Polling Place:
1. No person shall distribute or display any circular or printed matter.
 2. No person shall suggest or solicit any support for any candidate, party or public question **WITHIN 100 FEET OF THE OUTSIDE ENTRANCE TO ANY POLLING PLACE OR ROOM.**
- E. Persons Allowed in Polling Place:
1. Officers connected with the election
 2. Candidates
 3. Duly authorized challengers
 4. Voters as are present for the purpose of voting
 5. Persons connected with the operation of a simulated election for minors and minors present for the purpose of voting in a simulated election as permitted by N.J.S.A. 19:34-6b.
