

**§ 5-12. SOILING AND DEFECATING—DOMESTICATED ANIMALS.**

No person owning, walking or otherwise having custody or possession of any domesticated animal kept for amusement or companionship shall cause, suffer or permit such domesticated animal to soil, defile, defecate on, or commit any nuisance on any curb, street, sidewalk, park, playground, school land, or upon any private property without the permission of the owner of the private property obtained in the last instance.

Any person owning, walking or otherwise having custody or possession of any domesticated animal which soils, defecates on, or commits any nuisance on any curb, street, sidewalk, park, playground, school land, or upon any private property without the permission of the owner of said private property in the last instance, shall immediately remove all feces deposited by any such domesticated animal, which removal shall be in a sanitary manner by shovel, scoop or other device, and placed in a container and promptly disposed of in a sanitary manner.
