## Borough Updates from December:

- Assessor Meeting The new Assessor gave a great presentation on 12/11 on how assessments are derived. Watch it here: <u>https://highlandsnj.gov/missed-last-nights-property-tax-assessment-town-hall/</u>
- Captain's Cove AINR The 12/12 Land Use Board hearing on possible condemnation was postponed to 1/9/25.
- Shadowlawn AINR The Council appointed the contract purchaser as the Conditional Redeveloper on 12/18.
- Emergency Services Calls answered: First Aid Squad = 38; Fire = 19; Police = 540
- **Code Enforcement –** Summons = 11; Warnings = 2; Reports = 15; Inspections = 19; Permits = 12; OPRA = 13
- Building Department Inspections = 62; Passed = 53; Failed = 8; Not Ready = 1; Permits issued = 12
- Grants Awarded amount so far in 2024 is \$1,980,410

## Current Project Updates

- **REPI Living Shoreline & Bulkhead Design & Permitting** US DOD grant OF \$219,676, permits are approved by DEP. Submitted to Army Corps. After ACE approval, looking to submit for the grant implementation.
- **Portland Road Drainage Improvements** DOT grant of \$261,900 was awarded 10/6. NJNG worked over the Holidays to resolve conflicts regarding depth of gas line.
- Asset Activation James T. White Clam Plant NJEDA Grant of \$50,000 for planning upgrades, due in April, 2025.
- US DOT Safe Street & Roads for All Comprehensive transportation safety action plan for the entire Borough spanning 28 months by the County, \$1,475,000 total cost, Fed grant = \$1,180,000 + County grant = \$295,000.

## Planned Projects for 2025

- Overlook Park Creation [empty lot on NJSH 36] Survey & concept plan in works. MCOS \$148k + DCA \$74k
- Frank Hall Park Updates Survey & concept plan in works. MCOS \$86,000. Will be bid with Overlook to maximize potential cost savings.
- Jones Creek Dredging DEP approved 7/31/24, the County will complete, waiting for dates.
- Marine PI Elevated Walkway East [Sea Drift] Monmouth County CDBG grant \$167,000.
- Shore Drive Pedestrian Safety Improvements Sidewalks from Waterwitch to Willow. DOT \$284,000
- Washington Avenue Paving Mill & pave of Washington Ave from Marine Pl. to Cheerful Pl.

#### <u>Grants won – projects to be permitted & awarded</u>

- Linden, WW, Bay & Snug Harbor Estimated \$1.7 Million project to improved Drainage on these roads \$1.3 Million from DOT Local Aid. Waiting for DEP approval of the project in order to go out to bid.
- Grand Tour Drainage Improvements Project estimate \$1 million, Grant \$217,456.

#### Grants waiting to hear back

- **2022 FEMA BRIC** Combines flood mitigation and green infrastructure. In pre-award stage while Environmental Assessment [EA] ongoing, once EA completed [around March 2025], final DEP review will begin. Project = \$16,205,280; Grant = \$12,193,960.
- **Reconnect Communities** Planning grant elevated walkway, Waterwitch-Kavookjian. Submitted 9/30 \$111,780.
- American Firefighter's Grant New radios for the FD, submitted for \$160,725.
- American Firefighter's Grant Pump Truck for the FD, proposal for grant writing submitted on 12/20.
