Borough Updates from January:

- Shadowlawn AINR The Conditional Redeveloper signed the Interim Agreement & provided escrow on 1/6.
- Captain's Cove AINR The Land Use Board hearing on possible condemnation was postponed for now.
- Bay Avenue AINR The Council appointed the owner of 289 Bay as the Conditional Redeveloper on 1/15.
- Emergency Services Calls answered: First Aid Squad = 20; Fire = 15; Police = 638
- Code Enforcement Summons = 11; Warnings = 6; Reports = 20; Inspections = 20; Permits = 11; OPRA = 7
- Building Department Inspections = 64; Passed = 51; Failed = 9; Not Ready = 4; Permits issued = 20

Current Project Updates

- **Portland Road Drainage Improvements** DOT grant of \$261,900 was awarded 10/6. NJNG relocation work to be completed in Feb. Contractor started work 1/20 work should be complete by May, weather permitting.
- Asset Activation James T. White Clam Plant NJEDA Grant of \$50,000 for planning upgrades, due 4/18.

Planned Projects for 2025

- Marine PI Elevated Walkway East [Sea Drift] Monmouth County CDBG grant \$167,000. Bid open 2/27.
- Washington Avenue Paving Mill & pave of Washington Ave from Marine Pl. to Cheerful Pl. Bid open 3/13.
- Shore Drive Pedestrian Safety Improvements Waterwitch Willow sidewalks. DOT \$284,000. Bid open 3/13.
- Frank Hall Park Updates Survey & concept plan in works. MCOS \$86,000. Will be bid with Overlook to maximize potential cost savings. Going out to bid soon.
- Overlook Park Creation [empty lot on NJSH 36] Construction docs near finished. MCOS \$148k + DCA \$74k
- Jones Creek Dredging DEP approved 7/31/24, exploring options for completion.
- **REPI Living Shoreline & Bulkhead Design & Permitting** US DOD grant OF \$219,676, permits are approved by DEP. Submitted to Army Corps. After ACE approval, looking to submit for the grant for implementation.

Grants won – projects to be permitted & awarded

- **Linden, WW, Bay & Snug Harbor** Estimated \$1.7 Million project to improved Drainage on these roads \$1.3 Million from DOT Local Aid. Waiting for DEP approval of the project to go out to bid.
- Grand Tour Drainage Improvements Project estimate \$1 million, Grant \$217,456. Need to survey the area.

Grants waiting to hear back

- **2022 FEMA BRIC** Combines flood mitigation and green infrastructure. In pre-award stage now while Environmental Assessment [EA] is ongoing, once EA is completed [around March 2025], final DEP review will begin. Project = \$16,205,280; Grant = \$12,193,960.
- American Firefighter's Grant Pump Truck for the FD, grant not awarded, exploring options for purchase.
- **T-Mobile Hometown Grant** A \$50k grant to fund the sculpting and installation of a statue honoring Captain Joshua Huddy, a local American Revolutionary War hero. The proposed installation will be located at Huddy Park in Highlands, just 150 feet from where Captain Huddy was hanged in 1782. We should hear by the end of May.

Community Rating System [CRS] Update

We continue the CRS Certification process and work with property owners in the flood zone to build resiliently.
