## **Borough Updates for July:**

- Shadowlawn AINR In negotiations for Developer's Agreement.
- Captain's Cove AINR A prospective redeveloper has expressed interest but has not yet submitted plans.
- Bay Avenue AINR Conditional Redeveloper for 289 Bay is in negotiations for Developer's Agreement.
- Emergency Services Incidents: First Aid Squad = 41; Fire = 36; Police = 984
- Code Enforcement Summons = 4; Warnings = 12; Reports = 22; Inspections = 26; Permits = 12; OPRA = 23
- Building Department Inspections = 57; Passed = 40; Failed = 11; Not Ready = 6; Permits issued = 19

#### **Current Project Updates- Weather Permitting**

- Washington Avenue Paving Marine Pl. to Cheerful Pl. Started ADA 6/12, completion by the end of Aug.
- Portland Road Drainage Improvements Drainage work is completed. Mill & pave by end of Aug/Sept.
- Marine PI Elevated Walkway East [Sea Drift] Started ADA 6/12 should be complete before Labor Day.
- Shore Drive Pedestrian Safety Improvements Completed 7/2, 4 trees will be planted in the fall on Central Ave.

#### Planned Projects in 2025

• Frank Hall Park Updates & Overlook Park Creation – Survey & concept plan completed. MCOS \$86,000 FHP & OP MCOS \$148k + DCA \$74k. We bid on the parks together to maximize potential cost savings. Needed to rebid due to bid errors by contractors. New bids to come back on 8/14 recommendation from engineering 8/18, for possible award 8/20.

### Grants won – projects to be permitted & awarded

- Linden, WW, Bay & Snug Harbor Drainage Improvements Estimated \$1.7 Million project to on these roads \$1.3 Million from NJDOT Local Aid Grant. Waiting for DEP Letter of Support of the project to go out to bid.
- Grand Tour Drainage Improvements Project estimate \$1 million, Grant \$217,456. Work moved to 2026.

### Grants submitted waiting to hear back

- County Open Space 7/2025 Resurface playgrounds at Vets, Huddy and Rec, also fix courts at Snug.
- CDBG 7/2025 New Sidewalks on 36 from Linden to Waterwitch & Waterwitch from 36 to Linden around HES.
- Safe Roads to Transit 7/2025 New sidewalks on 36 from Waterwitch to Valley Ave.
- **REPI Living Shoreline & Bulkhead Design & Permitting** US DOD grant OF \$219,676, permits are approved by DEP. Army Corps permit submitted, now under technical review.

### **Grants being explored**

- Sanitary Sewer Phase II NJ Water Bank, USDA Water & Waste & other options being explored.
- Overpass Walkway over R36 Looking to resubmit for funding with State & County options.
- **Flood mitigation & Green Infrastructure** Project = \$16,205,280. We were waiting for comments from the State Historic Preservation Office. BRIC cancelled by E.O. on 4/18/25. Looking elsewhere for funding.
- New First Ad Building Possible Congressionally Directed Spending, also looking at modular solutions.
- New Pumper Truck for FD Exploring options for purchase.
- **Bronze Huddy Statute** –The proposed installation will be located at Huddy Park, just 150 feet from where he was hanged in 1782. We are looking for County & State grants.

## Community Rating System [CRS] Update

The CRS Certification process continues as we work with property owners in the flood zone to build resiliently.
