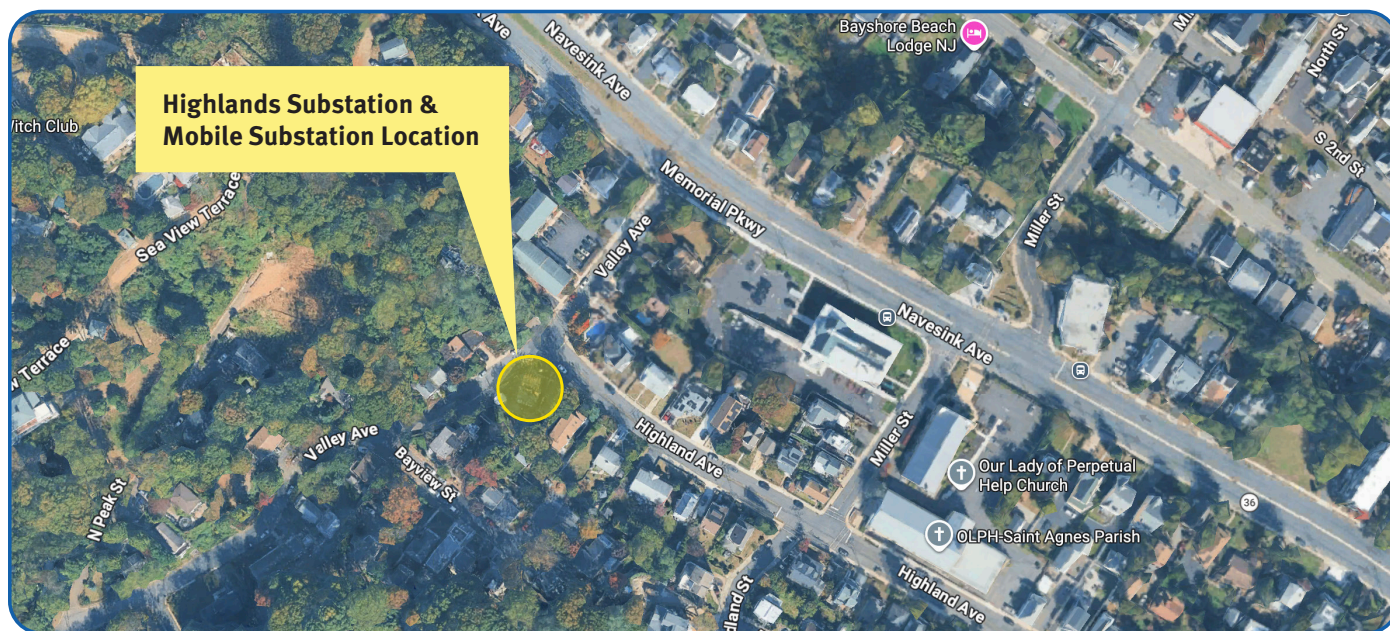


Community Notice for Highlands Borough Substation Reliability Project

Jersey Central Power & Light (JCP&L) will perform work at the Highlands Borough substation throughout September and October to enhance the safety and reliability of the local electric system. The work includes replacing damaged switches that allow crews to safely isolate electrical equipment for maintenance and repairs.

Residents may notice construction and utility crews around Highland Avenue, Valley Avenue and Bayview Street, along with the delivery and installation of specialized equipment. JCP&L will work to complete the project safely and efficiently while minimizing impacts to the surrounding community.



The Highlands substation and temporary mobile substation are pinned on the map. Residents can expect to see utility activity in the surrounding area, including along Highland Avenue, Valley Avenue and Bayview Street.

TEMPORARY MOBILE SUBSTATION

To minimize impacts to customers while repairs are underway, JCP&L will install a temporary mobile substation next to the existing facility. The mobile substation will support electric service while allowing crews to safely take the damaged equipment out of service and complete the necessary repairs.

The mobile substation is a self-contained electrical facility mounted on a 32-foot-long, 8-foot-wide tandem-axle trailer. It will be placed on an oil containment system designed to protect the surrounding environment. A temporary security fence will also be installed around the equipment to protect public safety and keep the site secure throughout the project.

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- **Week of August 31:**
Site preparation activities begin
- **Week of September 7:**
Mobile substation installation begins
- **Approximately September 16:**
Mobile substation placed in service
- **Approximately October 13:**
Project completion and removal of temporary equipment
